Sports and membership platforms, cybersecurity and managed network infrastructure. US-based clients.

- **Own the replatform of a legacy membership and sports-management system** end to end — discovery, requirements, backlog, engineering coordination, UAT, release. Sequenced the migration by member-facing risk rather than module convenience: registration and renewals first, reporting and admin tooling last.
- **Shipped natural-language search across membership, program and policy content.** Defined the retrieval layer — chunking strategy, metadata filters for member type and season — and built a golden-question set used as a regression suite before each release. Set an explicit confidence floor: below threshold the system returns ranked links instead of a generated answer, because a wrong answer about eligibility costs more than no answer. Measured on answer acceptance and zero-result rate, not query volume.
- **Run discovery as a standing practice, not a phase.** Weekly calls with club admins and registrars, an opportunity-solution tree mapped to each quarter's outcome, and assumption tests before engineering commits — a concierge test on eligibility rules killed a rules-engine build that would have taken most of a quarter.
- **Work at the contract level with engineering on integrations** — request/response shape, auth flows, field mappings, error semantics, idempotency on retries, and what happens when a third-party system is simply down. Integration failure modes go into the spec, not into a bug ticket three sprints later.
- **Lead Agile delivery across distributed teams** — sprint planning, refinement, stand-ups, reviews, retros, dependency and release planning. Prioritize with RICE and MoSCoW; use JTBD switch interviews when the question is why someone moved, not what they clicked. Own the client side too — feasibility, scope trade-offs, defect triage, release readiness.
- **Contribute to security and infrastructure product work** across a converged NOC + SOC model — SD-WAN and managed Wi-Fi requirements, network monitoring, firewall and endpoint policy, MDR/EDR, IAM and Zero Trust / SASE discussions. Most of the value is triage logic: performance issue, config drift, or actual security event.

- Owned the full product lifecycle across 2 squads — roadmap, backlog, sprint delivery and release — for Finance and HCM apps used by mid-market Workday customers. Managed engineers, QA and design directly.
- Shipped automated approval workflows with configurable cost-center rules and audit logging. Payroll teams that previously chased manual sign-offs now had a clear queue, escalation path and paper trail.
- Ran the research loop that fed the roadmap: workflow shadowing with payroll and finance ops, stakeholder interviews and funnel analysis on where approvals stalled. Findings shaped what we built next — and, as often, what we cut.
- Established a product analytics baseline and a closed feedback loop with active customers, which gave the team a signal on adoption rather than just shipping against a roadmap.

- Built and owned **7 storefront modules** — cart, PDP, checkout, returns, profile, support, gifting — across the full stack, including the ERP ↔ storefront ↔ CRM sync that kept inventory and order state consistent across channels.
- Shipped checkout UX changes — guest flow, autofill, address validation — and ran the A/B tests behind them. Owned the hypothesis and the instrumentation, not just the code. Measured on completed checkouts, not click-throughs.
- Partnered with data science on a **recommendation engine** for homepage and PLP personalization: defined segmentation logic and behavior-based decision trees, and designed the holdout so the lift was clearly attributable before we called it done.
- Integrated Apple Pay, Razorpay and Stripe with sub-1% transaction failure targets. Built New Relic alerting tuned to catch payment degradation before it showed up in customer complaints during global sale events.
- Grew into delivery ownership across 2 pods — sprint planning, estimation, retros, release planning. Moved the team from ad-hoc estimation to consistent story-point calibration and burn-up tracking over about two quarters.
